4. Support the development of a network of scholars and practitioners for future research and the development of interventions.

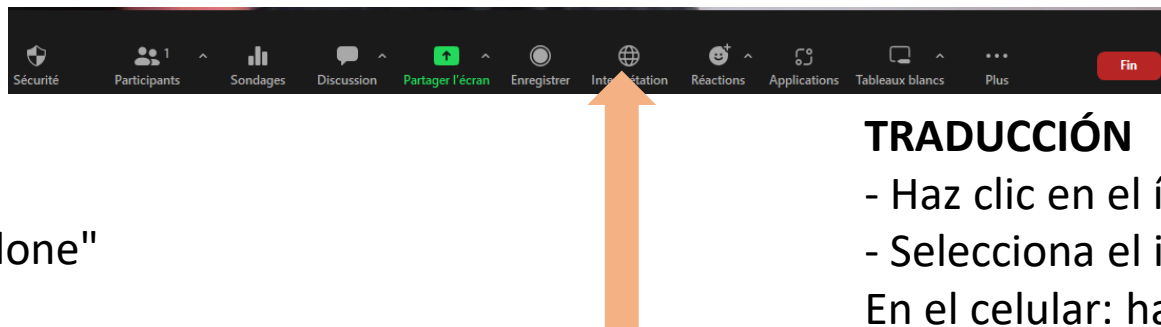

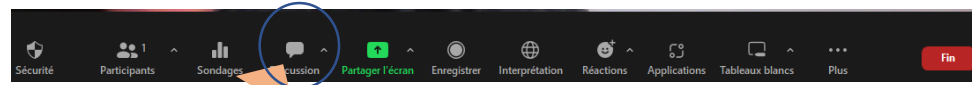
