Confidence in the 16:8 milking interval split

Managing a dairy enterprise across two blocks in Co. Laois, Bernard Ging has operated a 16:8 milking interval since the farm's conversion to milk production in 2012. Supported by two full-time staff, three relief milkers and students occasionally, Bernard finds that the 16:8 split has brought a start and finish time to the day on the dairy farming business, through which 340 cows are milked. Depending on proximity to the parlour, morning milking commences at 7:10-7:15am and evening milking starts at 3:30pm. This strategy, Bernard explained, ...
