Determining the efficiency of contractors in clearing invasive alien plant species: The case of the Mopani District, Limpopo province, South Africa

We analyse the efficiencies of 49 contractors in two catchments for three time periods, namely 2003 to 2006, 2007 to 2010 and 2011 to 2014. It was found that the size of the contract areas allocated for clearing decreased slightly from 2003 to 2014, while the unit costs (in real terms) have increased

considerably.

Evaluating the results of an agricultural cooperative support programme: Business practices, access to finance, youth employment

The “Impact report” series disseminates research reports from Taqueem-supported impact evaluations. Reports include baseline, endline and qualitative studies which describe the impact estimates of evaluations of youth employment interventions based on experimental and quasi-experimental designs.

This report assesses the effects of an intervention designed to enhance cooperative managers’ business skills, cooperatives’ overall competitiveness and cooperative members’ income and employment conditions, as well as food security in Rwanda. The research explores the short-term impact of the intervention on the employment, organizational, marketing and financial outcomes of agriculture cooperatives.

Factors that contribute to insecticide poisoning among immigrant agricultural workers in Thailand

The purpose of this study was to explore the factors that contribute to the development of symptoms of insecticide poisoning among immigrant agricultural workers in the eastern region of Thailand. Only 4.4% of the workers had normal levels of cholinesterase activity and 75.1% had levels that were abnormal. Regarding factors that affect gastrointestinal symptoms of poisoning, being aged 45 to 50 increased the risk of developing gastrointestinal symptoms (odds ratio (OR): 2.51; 95% CI: 1.41-4.46), as did using a backpack spraying technique (OR: 3.74; 95% CI: 2.16-6.49) and having only moderate levels of self-protection behavior while spraying the insecticides (OR: 2.23; 95% CI: 1.16-4.29). Having an at risk level of cholinesterase activity

increased the risk of gastrointestinal symptoms (OR: 3.25; 95% CI: 1.05-10.04) and the risk of respiratory symptoms (OR: 2.75; 95% CI: 1.17-6.44).

The Upper Limit of Cost for Entrusting External Contractors with cultivation and ensiling at a TMR Center

At most TMR Centers, composing farms labor conducts cultivation and ensilage. However, since 2006, an increasing number of Centers have begun entrusting these activities to external contractors. The case that we have analyzed is one where the TMR Center has switched cultivation and ensilage from composing farmers to an external operator. So we use this case to clarify the reasons for making the change away from using composing farmers' labor, which is linked to rising costs to produce TMR, and calculate the upper cost limit associated with changing to an external contractor.

Quelle vulnérabilité des travailleurs européens face aux conditions de travail dégradées ?

Les mutations organisationnelles et technologiques engendrent des risques de dégradation des conditions de travail susceptibles d'affecter le bien-être et la santé des travailleurs. À partir de données recueillies entre 1995 et 2015 pour les quinze pays fondateurs de l'Union européenne, ce 4-pages dresse le portrait des travailleurs les plus vulnérables au cumul de conditions de travail dégradées et illustre les différences entre pays européens. De plus, les CDD, le travail indépendant et les petites entreprises (1 à 9 salariés) sont associés à une plus grande vulnérabilité des travailleurs.
